Supporting Children and Young People after Flooding

This course has been developed based on research carried out by Lancaster University in conjunction with Save the Children and the Economic & Social Research Council.

The objective of the course is to provide case studies to assist in the understanding of the day to day issues faced by children and young people during what is often a long and isolating recovery period enabling those in contact with the families to provide the right support.

Water Damage Management: an overview

This course focuses on the high level activities carried out by the damage management and restoration industries acting as part of the insurance industry supply chain. It provides information on some key principles that can be used to define the most appropriate solution dependent on the circumstances of the claim.

This BDMA certification combines a series of Health & Safety modules considered essential for anyone working on or attending site where there is a perceived level of complexity and risk to be considered.
